### **RETURN TO SCHOOL**

With regards to our return to school in the 2020/21 academic year we are in a difficult position to explain specific arrangements, as the guidance issued by DE is changing so often.

Currently, the latest DE guidance requires that classrooms **should** have 1m distancing between children and 2m between the children and their teacher/classroom assistant. Obviously this has a huge impact on normal schooling in terms of accommodating full class returns and will result in part time schooling. However, we are hoping that DE's guidance is relaxed for schools over the summer months to allow **all pupils** to return to full time schooling.

We feel it is wise at this stage not to commit or plan rigidly for the new term but instead wait until final guidance is forthcoming. This guidance may not be available until the end of August as the Covid19 restrictions are constantly changing.

As a parent, I can appreciate that clarity is what we all seek and I can assure you that as soon as we are in a sound position to outline definitively what arrangements will be in place in August/September, we will do so.

Based on our current class sizes and making use of available accommodation we can confirm:

- <u>our P7 class only</u> will return to school on the <u>Monday 24<sup>th</sup> August</u> on a full time basis. We have no clarity on school meals or transport so the P7 pupils are requested to bring a packed lunch to school on their first day back.
- **P5 and P6** will return to school on **1**<sup>st</sup> **September** on a full time basis.
- <u>P1 P4</u> will return to school on the <u>1<sup>st</sup> September</u> but whether it is on a part time or full time capacity cannot be confirmed until the final guidance has been provided. (please note P1 pupils have staggered days for starting school as outlined at the induction meeting)

#### CONFIRMATION

Good luck to our P7 pupils who will receive the sacrament of Confirmation tomorrow evening.
