The ActivPanel is the premium interactive display for immersive learning and provides a tablet-like experience at the front of the classroom. Last year, with the support of the PSG, we purchased four ACTIV panels which replaced some of our aging interactive boards. This was a £9500 investment but both staff and pupils agree that it was an invaluable enhancement to the classrooms. This fundraiser will support in equipping all our classrooms with ACTIV panels and will directly benefit everyone in the school.
