### **WELCOME BACK**

A huge welcome back is extended to all our pupils throughout the school, with a particular welcome to our new pupils commencing Primary One and to Mr Campbell who has returned to the teaching staff. We hope that everyone will have an enjoyable and rewarding year ahead!

### **SCHOOL TIMES**

School starts for all classes at 9am. The back gate will be opened every morning at 8.50am and closed when classes start. It is essential that the children arrive to school on time and are seated in their classrooms for 9am.

The school pick up times are as follows:

- P1-P3 (2pm)
- P4-P7 (3pm)

All school arrivals and school pickups should take place at the back entrance of the school via the Church carpark. **Please note only children who are attending the morning club or who are arriving by bus should enter the school via the front entrance.** As always, we ask that when arriving and exiting the carpark you drive slowly and consider that children are making their way in or out of the school.

Should you need to collect a child during the school day please come to the main entrance of the school and your child will be brought to you. ***Thankyou in advance!***

### **MORNING CLUB PROVISION**

The morning club operates daily from 8.15am at a cost of £2 per child per day. ***(no booking is required)*** Please note children attending the morning club should use the front entrance of the school and make their way to the school hall.

### **REMINDER - P1 STARTING DATES**

To help progression into school life and routine we ask that during the month of September the P1 children be collected at the following times:

- **Start date - Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> September – 12 noon**
- **Monday 25<sup>th</sup> September - 2.00pm** *(Please note the children will need dinner money or a packed lunch from this date – details of this to follow)*

### **AFTER SCHOOLS (P1-P3 Bridging Club)**

The daily afterschool bridging club (2pm-3pm) will commence on **Monday 4<sup>th</sup> September** at a cost of £2 per child per day. This provision is only available for children who have older siblings in P4-P7. If you are using this club, please send in an envelope with the days needed and payment included on a Monday to the class teacher.

Please note P1 children can use this club from **Monday 25<sup>th</sup> September**.

### **SCHOOL DINNERS**

The cost of dinner money is **£2.60 per day** and **£13.00 per week**. Please send all monies to school in a clearly labelled envelope (name of child and class) every Monday to avoid unnecessary confusion.

### **HEALTHY EATING POLICY**

We operate a healthy eating policy at break time. Please ensure your child/ children bring fruit or vegetables with either milk or water. Please note, this does not include yoghurts, breakfast bars or sandwiches. Though this policy does not operate at lunchtime, we would encourage healthy options for those children who bring packed lunches.

### **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

We would ask that all the children's clothing is labelled clearly to avoid unnecessary confusion.

### **MOBILE NUMBERS**

Anyone who has changed their mobile numbers over the summer holidays is asked to notify the school to ensure that our records are up to date and that the school text messages are going to the correct number.

### **P7 PARENTS - POST PRIMARY TRANSFER - ENTRANCE ASSESSMENT**

Registration for the assessment will close on **Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2023**. If you wish your child to complete the Entrance Assessment you **must** register him/her by visiting the website: <https://seagni.co.uk/>. Each application requires an administration fee of £20.
